



PATIENTS FIRST EUREKA OFFICE TO OPEN AUGUST 2, 2010
Offering Full-Service Urgent Care and Pediatrics
Local Physician, Dr. John DuBois, will Join Patients First on November 1, 2010

Washington, MO, July 23, 2010 – The Patients First Health Care Eureka Office will officially open on Monday, August 2, 2010. The facility is located at 20 Legends Parkway in Eureka, off of Hwy 109 South. The Eureka Office is the 17th location for Patients First, which includes an Urgent Care and the pediatric practice of Jesse Groh, MD, FAAP.

The Patients First Urgent Care will be open daily to the public, including weekends. Hours will be 8 am to 8 pm Monday through Friday, and 8 am to 6 pm on Saturday and Sunday. The Eureka Urgent Care will offer treatment for non-emergent issues, such as sore throats, ear infections, scrapes and burns, insect bites and rashes. Appointments are not required. Urgent Care is a convenient and efficient means of accessing health care needs when a patient cannot see their own physician or when a patient does not have a personal physician. The Urgent Care is staffed with board-certified physicians, nurses, and x-ray and lab technologists. Most insurance plans are accepted. The pediatric practice of Jesse Groh, MD, FAAP, will also open on August 2nd, at the same location at 20 Legends Parkway. Children and young adults are seen by appointment only and office hours are available Monday through Friday. Board certified by the American Board of Pediatrics, Dr. Jesse Groh is also a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics. Appointments are now being accepted by calling (636) 549-0121.

Dr. John DuBois, DO, an internal medicine physician in Eureka, will be joining Patients First and moving his practice to the Patients First Eureka location on November 1, 2010. Additional primary care practices will open in late fall, with specialty practices to follow. Current diagnostic capabilities include digital x-ray, ultrasound and bone densitometry. An electronic medical records (EMR) system connects all physicians throughout the Patients First network. EMR is a centralized, secure patient information system, which improves the quality of care by allowing health care providers to share all patient information when diagnosis or treatment occurs.
