Dr. Schloss is board certified in internal medicine, cardiovascular medicine, adult comprehensive echocardiography, nuclear cardiology and board eligible in interventional cardiology and endovascular medicine.

A published author of several medical journal articles, Dr. Schloss is also a member of the American College of Cardiology and the Society for Cardiovascular Angiography and Interventions. His special interests include valvular heart disease, acute coronary syndromes, and both venous and arterial endovascular medicine.
